【講義の目的・内容】

The purpose of the first-year seminar is to acquire the most basic skills necessary to successfully fulfill all the degree requirements in media and communications studies. While each professor may use different methods, approaches, or teaching materials, the fundamental aim remains the same.

- 4. The instructor will show you how to revise and develop the products of your work.

【事前・事後学修】

Before each class meeting, complete the suggested assignments, which may include readings, collecting related materials and data, and preparing agendas and PowerPoint slides. In some cases, group work will be expected.

After each class meeting, reflect on what you have learned in class to ensure that you have acquired the basic skills of searching for materials, preparing agendas, and how to make a presentation. Students have to study 3 hours every week.
